All vessels arriving for transit must report to the ACP boarding officers their Blind Distance calculated for tropical fresh water at conning positions 1, 2 and 3. The "Blind Distance" is the forward distance from the bow of the vessel to the closest point on the water's surface which can be seen from all conning positions in the navigation bridge. An observer's height of eye of 1.80 meters above the bridge deck must be used to determine this distance, and must be reported in ship lengths. The Blind Distance at conning position #1 is not applicable to vessels with centerline cranes.
